

Troparion of the Ninth Hour

Following the appointed *kathisma* from the Psalter, the chanter chants the following Lenten troparion of the Ninth Hour, in the eighth (fourth plagal) tone with its verses. At the end of each chanting of the troparion, a prostration is made.

Verse 1: Let my supplication draw nigh before thee, O Lord; according to thine oracle give me understanding.
