## Troparion of Second Antiphon (Only-Begotten Son)

O Only-begotten Son and Word of God who art immortal, yet didst deign

for our sal-va-tion to be incarnate of the holy Theotokos and ever vir-gin Mar-y,

and by thy death didst Death sub-due, who art one of the Ho-ly Trin-i-ty,
