V. 1: Judge me, O Lord; for I have walked in my innocence: and hoping in the Lord I shall not be moved. I will wash my hands in innocence, and compass Thine altar, O Lord.. (Ps. 25:1,6) R.

V. 2: To hear the voice of praise, and to declare all thy wonderful works. (Ps. 25:7) R.

V. 3: O Lord, I have loved the beauty of thy house, and the place of the tabernacle of thy glory (Ps. 25:8) R.

V. 5: Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, both now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.  
(Then sing "Only begotten Son . . . .")

NOTE: If the feast falls on a Sunday, sing "Who art risen from the dead." Otherwise, sing "Who art wondrous in the saints."
