Tithing Envelopes

The tithing envelopes may be used as the students' "piggy bank" for Church—as soon as they receive their allowance or gift money, they are to place a portion in their envelope. We suggest that the students' envelopes be placed at the icon corners in the students' homes. This reinforces that caring for the Church is a holy act.

Purchase enough envelopes for the students. Have them seal the envelope and then cut open one end so that it can be folded down to hold the money.

The logo sticker goes on the envelope, along with the student's name. The child empties the envelope into either the classroom donation box that will be presented to an usher, or into the collection basket during the Divine Liturgy. The envelope is to be retained by the child and reused.

Have extra envelopes and stickers ready for lost envelopes as the year continues.
