The exhibit, "Scripture through the Lens of the Holy Land" will be at St. George's parish April 24 and 25 [Times and details—maybe two reservation times about 30 minutes apart so a quiet atmosphere can be maintained.] The inspirational and stunning exhibit begins with Eden and allows you to walk the Path of Salvation through time. For the spiritual seeker, the alcoves of seven-foot banners provide an escape to a distant land where palms can be seen, soft music from the hills of Galilee can be heard, and the air is fragrant with sweet basil and cinnamon. Scriptural passages allow history to touch the present day. Quiet your mind and let the illustrations, scriptural writings and almost 100 photos of holy sites enrich your understanding of God's plan for the world. Go back to where Christianity beganour faith is in a man who lived 2000 years ago, and lives still.
