seized them all; and they glorified God, saying,

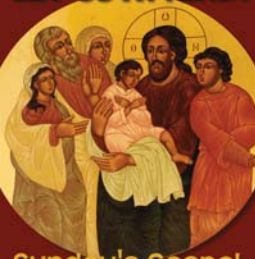
**People:** A great prophet has arisen among us!
