V. 1: The Lord hath sworn in truth unto David, and He will not annul it. (Ps. 131: 11) R.

V. 2: Of the fruit of thy loins will I set upon thy throne. (Ps. 131: 11) R.

V. 3: There will I make to spring forth a horn for David, I have prepared a lamp for My Christ. (Ps. 131: 18) R.

V. 4: For the Lord hath elected Zion; He hath chosen her to be a habitation for Himself (Ps. 131:13) R.

V. 5: Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, both now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.
(Then sing "Only begotten Son")

NOTE: If the feast falls on a Sunday, sing "Who art risen from the dead." Otherwise, sing "Who art wondrous in the saints."
