Antiochian Village is very pleased to welcome, as our guest speaker for this retreat, Archimandrite Meletios Webber .

Abbot Meletios was born in the UK, and received into the Holy Orthodox Church in 1971 by Bishop Kallistos Ware. He has served parishes in the UK, Greece, and the Netherlands, Montana and California, and has been living in the US since 1984.

He studied Theology in Oxford and in Thessalonika, and has a doctorate in psychological counseling from the University of Montana. He has taught at the university and high school levels both in the States and in Europe.

Father Meletios has authored two books: Bread & Water, Wine & Oil and Steps of Transformation, both published by Conciliar Press.

He is currently the abbot of the Monastery of St. John of San Francisco, a brotherhood of about twenty monks, in Manton, CA.

About the retreat topic, Father Meletios says, *“Orthodoxy has a great deal to say to the modern world, particularly in the realms of psychology and spirituality. These talks are aimed at providing the participants with a practical and personal experience of the prayer of the heart..”*
