



# Litany of the Fervent Supplication #2 115-A

PRIEST: Let us say with all our soul and with all our mind, let us say:




Lord have mer - cy.

PRIEST: Again we pray for mercy, life, peace, health, salvation and visitation, and pardon and remission of sins for the servants of God, all Orthodox Christians of true worship, who live and dwell in this community.

PRIEST: Again we pray for the blessed and ever-memorable founders of this holy Temple; and for all our fathers and brethren, the Orthodox departed this life before us, who here and in all the world lie asleep in the Lord.

PRIEST: Again we pray for those who bear fruit and do good works in this holy and all-venerable Temple; for those who serve and those who sing; and for all the people here present, who await thy great and rich mercy.

PRIEST: For thou art a merciful God and lovest mankind, and unto thee we ascribe glory; to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen.
